

Statement by Free Myanmar

We, the Free Myanmar movement considers the coup d'état that took place on February 1, 2021 as a continued cycle of dictatorship by the self-appointed and promoted Myanmar Military leaders since 1962. The coup was illegitimate and the merciless crush on peaceful protesters is in violation of human rights and international law.

We welcome the formation of the Committee Representing Pyidaungsu Hluttaw (CRPH) by the members of Pyidaungsu Hluttaw (Myanmar's Union Parliament) to perform duties that include, but are not limited to, forming a government and engaging with the international organizations including the United Nations.
